The Board reviewed a list of State contracts for the fiscal year 2024-25. The interior door project is no longer eligible for state reimbursement so the project was tabled.

The Board reviewed bids for roof replacement and elected to go with a metal roof. John Troyer and John Kramer were contacted by phone to answer questions regarding their bids. More information is needed. Elizabeth will prepare a list of questions which will be reviewed by the Board for completion before submission to the bidders. Action on the roof bids was tabled until the November meeting.
